

English

In English, we will be reading the book 'Freedom 1783' by Catherine Johnson. We will begin the half term by writing a biography about Harriet Tubman, focusing on structure and layout. Our fiction writing for the half term will be a descriptive narrative based on a slave ship. We will continue to develop our editing skills as well as practising up-levelling our writing.

Maths

We will begin the half term by covering decimals, including addition and subtraction with decimal numbers. We will also look at negative numbers and learn how to count through zero.

Computing

Our topic in computing this half term will be programming. We will be using scratch software to program a quiz. We will also add conditions which will have different outcomes based on answers.

RE

This half term we will continue exploring our focus question, 'If God is everywhere, why go to a place of worship?' We will look deeper into the worship of the three different religions (Christianity, Judaism and Hinduism) and the children will have opportunities to form balanced arguments.

Science

Our topic for this half term is 'Animals including Humans'. Through this, we will cover the different stages of human growth and development. We will be learning about the changes that the body goes through during puberty.

PHSCE

Our topic this half term is 'Bullying Matters'. We will learn about the different types of bullying and its impacts on people. We will also learn strategies for getting support.

Design Technology

This half term we will be designing and creating a stuffed toy. We will be learning how to sew a blanket stitch as well as how to sew decorations onto fabric.

Music

Our theme this half term is the 'Animal Kingdom'. We will explore how pitch, tempo and instruments can be used to represent animals whilst learning to use chords.

PE

Our PE units this half term are handball and swimming. This will focus on building up the knowledge of the rules in handball and how to attack/defend effectively.

History

Our topic this half term is all about slavery and the Transatlantic Slave Trade. We will learn about the role that the British Empire had during this time and what other countries gained from the Slave Trade. We will also learn about how slavery was abolished and understand Harriet Tubman's role in the Underground Railroad.

French

Our topic this half term is French family. We will be learning the vocab we need to say and write about the people in our families.
