We then watched a video which explained what we should do in case of a fire at home. Pupils were then given a Fire Safety sheet to take home and complete once they have assessed their own homes for fire safety.

Memorial visit.....

Year 4 visited the war memorial along with other schools from Chaddesden. We were honoured to be part of the service led by the Mayor of Derby and Vicar Jason Ward. Veterans of the armed forces guided us throughout and a veteran Royal Marine supported our school through the service. Year 4 were very respectful throughout the service and used the time to remember the fallen soldiers.

Anti-bullying week.....

Pupils and staff showed support to anti-bullying week by proudly wearing odd socks on Wednesday. We also took part in anti-bullying workshops delivered by PCSO Luke Shaw. Luke spoke in depth about the different forms of bullying with a focus on cyber bullying. As children spend more time online it is imperative they know when to remove themselves from chat groups and forums that are causing a negative impact. Pupils know the importance of reporting any signs of bullying to a trusted adult and know how bullying can have a negative effect on each other.
