Class induction swap.....

Next week is our whole school class induction. The plans for the two days are as follows –

For Nursery children starting Reception this September

On Tuesday the 1st July we are asking all 15 hour children to join us for the morning. Please drop your child off at the Nursery door. We are then inviting parents in at 11.45am – 12.30pm to join your child for lunch. You can then take your child home at 12.30pm. 30 hour children can stay as usual for the afternoon.

On Wednesday the 2nd July, all Nursery children are invited to stay for the whole day. Please drop your child off at the Reception door.

All children who are remaining in Nursery and not moving up to Reception are to remain on their normal hours.

For Reception – Year 5

On Tuesday the 1st of July all children will be dropped off at their normal classrooms and will then move to their new class following registration. After lunch they will then return to their normal classrooms.

On Wednesday 2nd July all children will be dropped off and collected from their new classrooms.

For Year 6 leavers

All Year 6 children will need to be dropped off and collected from their new secondary school. Please contact these schools directly to find out their transition arrangements as some schools have a third transition day on Thursday 3rd July.

Coffee morning.....

On Friday the 4th July we are inviting all parents and carers in to join us in classes to observe a writing lesson and then join us in the hall for tea and coffee. Please drop your child off at their class and then make your way to the office to sign in. We are looking forward to seeing lots of you joining our classes.

Attendance.....

Please remember that our school day begins at 8.45am. Some pupils are arriving late to school regularly – this disrupts the learning of other children and can take the teacher away from teaching. Please make every effort to get your child to school on time every day – it really is important that everyone has a settled and stable start to the school day so they do not miss out on important learning first thing. We also offer a breakfast club for children from 7.30am if this is something you require. The cost is £3.75 daily.

Our school target for attendance is to reach at least 96%. Please speak to your child's class teacher if you are struggling to bring your child into school or need any help or support. Our Education Welfare Officer works closely with us to offer support and give parents advice, if required.

Well done to Year 3 who have achieved the highest attendance last week with 96.71%.

Please remember the following school rules;

- Our school is a no smoking site. Please do not vape or smoke once you have entered our school gates.
- Please dismount all bikes and scooters before entering our playground gates. This is to keep everyone safe and avoid collisions.
- Our classroom doors open at 8.40am and close at 8.45am. At 8.45am our school gates are also closed and you will need to enter through the school office.
