## School rules and expectations.....

Please remember, as a school, we have the following expectations –

- Please arrive for 8.40am every day. School gates are locked at 8.45am and any arrivals after this time are required to enter through the school office.
- Please bring a named water bottle to school daily. Pupils are able to refill their bottles when required. We do not allow fruit juices or fizzy drinks in bottles.
- Please dismount from any bikes or scooters when entering the school grounds. You are more than welcome to leave bikes and scooters in our bike shed. Electric scooters are banned from school grounds.
- Please wear the correct uniform daily – please speak to your child's class teacher or refer to dojo to find out when your child's PE days are. The uniform policy is available on our website and school uniform is listed at the front of your child's homework diary on page 4.
- We are a no smoking site – parents and carers, please do not vape or smoke on school grounds.
- Please read a minimum of three times per week and record these reads in your child's homework diary. There are pages that must be signed (Page 5, 12 and 13) to consent to your child attending school trips and the safe use of ICT.
- If your child is going to be absent please let the office know before 9.00am. Please ring the school office and press option 1 to leave a voice message, we need to know the reason your child is absent, their name and year group. Please do not dojo your child's class teacher as these can be missed while teaching.
- Breakfast club needs to be pre booked weekly and paid for in advance on parent pay. We cannot guarantee accepting your child into breakfast club if you have not pre booked.
